Step-by-Step Instructions:

- 1. Go to My Events.
- 2. Tap **View Details**.
- 3. Click on **Announcements**.
- 4. In the **Create New Announcement** section, type your message.
- 5. As soon as you start typing, you'll see two options appear:
 - **Send:** Sends your push alert in **real time** to all attending guests
 - **Save:** Allows you to **draft an announcement** if you want to pre-write your notifications and send them when ready.
- 6. Once sent, your push alert will **notify guests directly on their mobile devices**, even outside the app, and will also **remain visible in the Announcements tab** inside the app in case they miss the initial alert.
- 7. While you **cannot delete** a push notification after it's been sent, you can still **edit it** if you'd like it to correct the post.

☐ Tips & Tricks

- Push alerts are automatically sent to **everyone who RSVP'd "Yes"** to your wedding.
- Use push notifications to:
 - Send reminders leading up to the wedding (e.g., meal selections, flight info, packing tips, or feature highlights).
 - Welcome guests as they arrive in town. (e.g., "Welcome to Charleston, we are happy you came!)
 - Send morning-of reminders (like ceremony start times).
 - Notify guests of real-time updates, such as when shuttles have arrived or when an event is starting.
- Wedding planners and hosts can use announcements to **keep everyone informed and on schedule** without having to text guests individually.

To save time, **pre-build** notifications in advance, save them as drafts, and send them later when needed.
