

The **Chat feature** is the heart of *The Wedding App* — it's what makes your wedding experience feel truly social and connected. It allows **everyone invited** to communicate in one central place — from private messages to group and community chats — making it fun, easy, and organized.



Direct Chat

(Similar to Instagram DMs)

You can send private messages to individual guests or create group chats.

To start a 1:1 message:

- 1. Go to the **Guests** page.
- 2. Click the **three dots** (for admins) or the **chat icon** (for guests) next to the person's name.
- 3. Once a message is started, it will appear and live under your **Chat** tab.

To start a group chat:

- 1. Go to **Chat**.
- 2. Click **Create Group** in the upper right corner.
- 3. Select the names of the guests you'd like to include.
 - (Note: Guests must have RSVP'd "Yes" to be included in group chats.)



Community Chat

(Similar to Facebook Groups)

The **Community Chat** is an open conversation space where *everyone attending* that specific wedding can connect.

It's perfect for casual communication among guests and helps build excitement before and during your celebration.

Here's how it can be used:

- Guests can ask questions like "Which hotel is everyone staying at?" — without having to message the couple directly.
- Share **real-time updates** (like "we just landed see you soon!").
- **Socialize and connect** before the big day to build momentum and excitement.
- Guests can post, comment, like, share, and even upload photos within the Community feed.





Tips & Tricks

Group Chat:

Great for wedding planners, coordinators, or family members who need to quickly reach the **wedding** party or share logistics in real time.

Community Chat:

Encourage guests to use this space to **share outfit inspiration**, **vision boards**, or simply **connect with one another**.

It's a fun, interactive way to make your event feel more personal and engaging — even before everyone arrives.
